- a. **Vice President's Report:** Things are going very smoothly this year. Getting ready for the winter sport season.
- b. **Concessions Report:** Percolator is broken. The marching band is considering purchasing two hard-wired hot chocolate machines for the concession stands. We will be purchasing three microwaves – one for outdoor west visitor concession stand, one for outdoor east and one for indoor west. Homecoming week last year \$6500 sales, this year \$8500 which includes the stand opening for the Freshman football games. A reminder to be sure to count tickets and turn them in for reimbursement from the school. All food has been removed from the visitor's concession stand. Chris Role is going to open the field to the Bloomingdale Bears teams. When the concession stand is opened for non-LP events, all food sold must be ready-made. Need to set up dates to train openers and closers for the winter season. Gina turned in \$600 bank to Margaret. Victoria turned in \$400 bank to Margaret on Friday. Gina will confirm with Bob if all units at outdoor west should be unplugged for the off season.
- c. **Spirit Wear & School Store:** Boosters has entered a joint venture with the baseball team this season. We have ordered 288 hats at a cost of \$5328. We will get the proceeds from the hats sold. Sherry will not be able to make any of the basketball games this season. Big thanks to Debbie for helping at the curriculum nights. School Store is open 2 days at east and once every other week at west campus. Goggles were sold. Feedback from two students and one secretary at west campus was that everything was too expensive. May need to reassess month to month.

- e. **Fundraising Report:** Need to schedule Texas Hold'em Dates. Sneakers were picked up last Tuesday. We had a total of 20 bags to be picked up, waiting for information on amount of money raised.
